

GRE is mandatory for the application of the IME Graduate Program and we request all the applicants to submit GRE Score. It is needed for the evaluation at the selection. If you do have specific reason and if you could explain it to us (for example, no more test will be held this year and you cannot take GRE test) we could consider the waiver of GRE score and we will send your application documents to the selection committee without your GRE score.

It might cause a slight disadvantage for you when all the other students submit GRE score. However, if you have good GPA or if you are ranked very high at your university by the professor who recommends you, which will prove your qualification, it might be all right.

1)

If you are going to take GRE test from now, you can submit on-line score by 17<sup>th</sup> of March, 2020 at the latest. Since the on-line score comes out on ETS web site about two weeks (ten working days) from the examination date, if you will be able to take the test before 1<sup>st</sup> of March, 2020, you can submit GRE score before the deadline, and we will be able to include your score to your application documents for the selection purpose.

In that case, please state the exact examination date on T-cens application Form#3. By this, the professors as well as IME Graduate Program Office will know that your GRE score is coming late but before the selection, even if your score is not ready by the end of on-line application.

2)

If you will not able to submit GRE score even we postpone the deadline till 17<sup>th</sup> of March, 2020, you are requested to upload the state of the reason why you cannot submit GRE Score on your T-cens page.

Please upload the state of the reason where the applicant is requested to upload GRE score.

By this, the selection committee will know the reason and consider that the reason is good enough for the waiver at the selection.
